LPFM Corner by Christy Lynn White

The LPFM window closed on November 15 and about 2,800 applications were received - a lot lower than the 10,000 some had predicted would be received. You can search applications on the [FCC website](#), or you can download a full Filing Window Application List from the [Skywaves website](#).



The burning question now, is when will we see new LPFM Construction Permits (CPs) from this boom of applications? On December 3rd, the FCC announced that it has identified some 900 technically-acceptable applications, and plans to start issuing construction permits for those without any conflict in January. Read the full [FCC Public Notice](#). The last window in 2000/2001 saw some groups wait over 10 years for an answer, but it is doubtful the process will run that long. For now, we have to wait and see how the process plays out.
