





Capturing the full spectrum of analog FM (HD is visible but not captured), its powerhouse processor and massive 13 TB hard drive turn every aspect of airwaves into recordings, to be picked apart with its dazzling array of software tools. Tools are available via the front panel touch screen or remotely using supplied Windows-based software.
